The first clubhouse of the Stratford Country Club was built in 1914 for \$7000. When constructed it was surrounded by farmland and the country lane which led to it, later became Delamere Avenue.

The building was erected a year after the nine hole golf course was opened for play in 1913, with many of the holes still in play today.

The original clubhouse served until just before Hallowe'en night in 1923, when flames destroyed the all wood structure. The current clubhouse of the Stratford Country Club is actually the third building on that site.
